2 RECOMMENDED SMOKY MOUNTAIN HIKES NEAR DOWNTOWN

If you want to go for a hike while you're visiting Gatlinburg, you will be happy to know there are several wonderful hikes near downtown!

The **Gatlinburg Trail** offers a perfect hiking option for anyone because it is an easy hike that is relatively flat. The trail travels for 1.9 miles from River Road in downtown Gatlinburg to the Sugarlands Visitor Center. The Gatlinburg Trail runs through the forest as it follows along the West Prong of the Little Pigeon River and offers beautiful view of the river. The foundations and chimneys of several old homesites are also visible along the trail.

Be sure to hike along the **Baskins Creek Falls Trail** during the summer. The main trailhead is found along Roaring Fork Nature Trail loop road, which is usually closed during the winter. This moderate 3-mile roundtrip hike descends on its way to the falls, which are absolutely beautiful and well worth the challenge of the return hike!
