The hit series follows a kind-hearted football coach from Kansas leading England's AFC Richmond — and it turns out the story has real-life roots. Coach Donnie Campbell, a Kansas high school math teacher and basketball coach, once

coached a young Jason Sudeikis at Shawnee Mission West. Years later, Sudeikis revealed on *The Late Show* with Stephen Colbert that Campbell partly inspired the lovable, wise character he plays on the Emmy-winning show. Campbell, now in the spotlight himself, has appeared on *Good Morning America* and *The Today Show*, sharing insights on leadership and the importance of building strong values. A Lyons High School grad and Kansas State football alum, he's spent more than 36 years shaping not just athletes, but confident, character-driven young people. In his colorful keynote, Coach Campbell shares the specific techniques he's used to build confidence, define missions, and motivate players on and off the court.
